Wasn't Roscoe brave? We all feel a little scared sometimes, especially when it's dark. But Roscoe learned a wonderful secret: **God's light is always with us, no matter how dark it seems!**

Think and Talk with Your Child:

- What was Roscoe most afraid of at the beginning of the story?
- How did the Glowbugs help Roscoe?
- Ollie the Owl shared a special verse from the Bible: "**The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear?**" (Psalm 27:1) What do you think that means?
- How can *you* remember that God is with you when you feel scared?

Fun Activities for Your Family:

1. **Glow-in-the-Dark Hunt:** Hide glow-in-the-dark stars or small, safe glow sticks around a dim room and let your child find them. Talk about how even a little light can help us see.
2. **Shadow Play:** Use a flashlight to make silly shadow puppets on the wall. Turn something "scary" (like a big monster shadow) into something funny!
3. **Nighttime Walk (with a flashlight!):** If it's safe, take a short walk just outside at dusk. Use a flashlight to discover how light reveals the beauty of the night (like Roscoe did with the Glowbugs!).

Remember, just like the Glowbugs showed Roscoe, God's love and light are always near, guiding and comforting us.
